

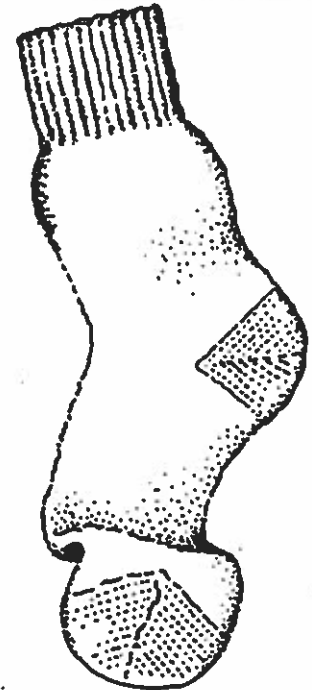

COLLECTING DATA

1. Reach into the sock and remove one paper clip.
2. List the color of the paper clip and put a tally mark in the chart.
3. Remove another paper clip. If the color is different from the first color, list the color in the chart and make a tally mark next to it. If the color is the same as the first color, put another tally mark next to the first color.
4. Continue taking paper clips out of the sock and recording their colors in the chart.
