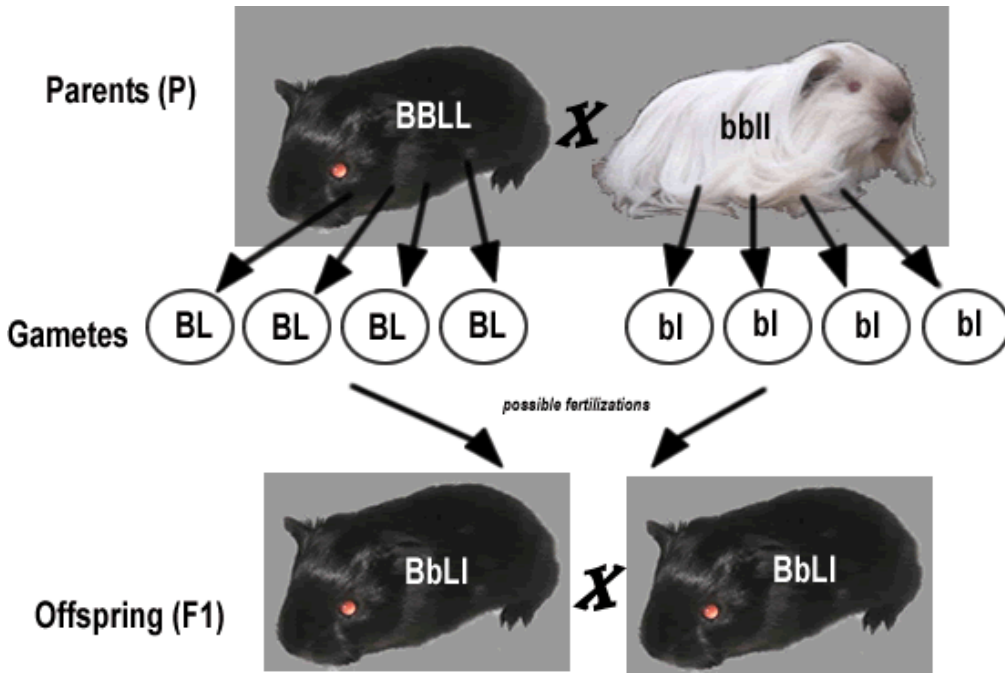


DIHYBRID CROSS
