#### What are Microscopes?

- Microscope: instrument used for viewing very small objects typically magnified several hundred times
- Simple Microscope: single convex lens to produce an enlarged image



### What are Microscopes?


 X: the amount of times the object has been magnified by lenses

 Hand lens - consists of a convex lens made of a piece of glass


or plastic

## What are Microscopes?

- Compound Microscope: instrument for forming magnified images small objects
- Most compound microscopes: have an objective lens and an eyepiece



# How do you prepare a wet mount slide?



- Add a drop of water to slide
- Place specimen in water
- Place edge of coverslip on side of water at angle and slowly lower it down
